

Bourgogne's Grand Crus: Saturday 23rd September – 9 a.m.

Immerse yourself in the exciting world of Bourgogne wines and, with wine glass in hand, access some of Bourgogne's legendary Grand Cru appellations! The entire history of a region will be revealed through this exceptional oenological class, from its vineyard plots to the *savoir-faire* of its winegrowers.

The fundamentals: Saturdays the 9th September; 7th and 28th October – 9 a.m.

With glass in hand, enter the exciting world of Bourgogne wines for half a day and learn the methodology of tasting.

Discovery day: Saturday 7th October – 9 a.m.


An introductory day combining the pleasure of tasting with that of discovering the vineyard, with several guided tours, including one at a wine estate.

A day of tasting: Saturday 28th October – 9 a.m.

Learn how to view, nose and taste white wines, red wines and Crémant de Bourgogne, and to identify their aromas. Keeping and serving wines, and pairing food with wine are also covered.

After a tasting-lunch, the afternoon is devoted to discovering the *terroirs* and appellations, with a study of the landscape followed by a tutored tasting on the themes of *terroirs* and vintages.

[NEW]: in each of the Cités, there are regular panel discussions on diverse and varied subjects related to the world of wine, its heritage and its challenges, in the presence of wine trade professionals.
